



**STOCKSBRIDGE PENTAQUA SWIMMING CLUB**  
**STOCKSBRIDGE SPRING SPRINTS**  
**SUNDAY 22nd APRIL 2012**

**Promoters' Conditions**

1. The competition will be held under A.S.A Laws and A.S.A Technical Rules.
2. The Pool is 25m long x 6 lanes with electronic timing and scoreboard. No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside, but footwear must be worn in the spectator's gallery and outside the pool marshalling area. Anti-wave ropes will be used.
3. Team Managers or coaches are responsible for their swimmers throughout the Meet and must supervise the warm up of their swimmers. They are responsible for their good behaviour and whereabouts at all times. Please do not let competitors wander around the Leisure Centre.
4. The age groups are as of 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2012 – 9 years, 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years and over. Swimmers are eligible to enter their own age group only.
5. The heats will be arranged according to submitted entry times. It is the swimmers and clubs responsibility to assure that all swimmers' are entered in the correct age group. Poolside entries will not be accepted.

The fastest 6 competitors in each age group, taken from the heats and taking in to account the cutoff and tolerance times, will be eligible to compete in the final. 6 finalists + 2 reserves only will be listed. If any finalists withdraw reserve/s will be called. In the event that more than 2 finalists subsequently drop out; then no additional reserves will be called.

- 6. Please note that this gala will be run without cards. A copy of their accepted entries will be emailed to each participating club.**
7. Swimmers must report to the competitors stewards two events prior to their own.
8. Awards will be made to finalists in each age group in each event irrespective of cutoff/tolerance times. Speeding Tickets will be awarded to those swimmers who exceed the cutoff times by more than one second during the heats. Disqualified swimmers are not eligible for any award.
9. Awards will be available from the trophy desk during the sessions, after event results have been announced / posted. Top boy/girl awards will be presented to the boy/girl accumulating the most points in each session. Points will be awarded on the basis of 1<sup>st</sup> – 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> – 3 points, 5<sup>th</sup> – 2 points, 6<sup>th</sup> – 1 point. In the event of a tie, the number of 1<sup>st</sup> places etc will decide the winner.
10. Full results will be placed on Stocksbridge Pentaqua SC's website ([stocksbridgepentaqua.co.uk](http://stocksbridgepentaqua.co.uk)) as soon as possible after the meet. Individual event result sheets may be purchased, during the gala, at the admissions desk at 20p per sheet.
11. The referee's decision will be final on all matters relating to swimming and swimmer discipline.
12. The promoters take no responsibility for lost property. Lockers are provided in the changing rooms .
- 13. In line with the recommendation in the ASA Child Protection Policy, any person wishing to engage in video, zoom or close range photography (including mobile phones with a photographic facility) should register their details, before the event, with staff at the spectator entry desk before carrying out any such photography. An authorisation pass will be issued and must be worn at all times. Any person not complying will be asked to leave the pool complex.**
14. Any matters not covered by these conditions shall be at the promoters' discretion if not covered by ASA Laws or Technical Rules.
