Venue: Scarborough Indoor Pool, Ryndle Crescent, Scarborough

Pool: 6 lane, 25m with Electronic Timing

Age Groups: 9yrs, 10 yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15+yrs (Age as on 17th June 2011)

Events: Backstroke, Breaststroke & Butterfly - 50m (all ages) and 100m (not 9yrs)
Freestyle - 50m, 100m (not 9yrs), 200m and 400m
Individual Medley - 100m and 200m

All the above events are Heat Declared Winners

A & B Grade Senior I.M. Skins - 13yrs and over - qualify from 200m I.M.

A & B Grade Junior I.M. Skins - 12 yrs and under - qualify from 100m I.M.

The qualifiers for the Male and Female skins will be the six fastest A grade and the six fastest B grade from the eligible age groups of the Individual Medley.

Awards:

- Age group individual races: For both A and B grade - Medals for 1st to 3rd plus additional awards depending upon the number in each grade.
- Open events - 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each age group plus extra awards depending upon the number in each age group.
- Skins: 1st = £50; Runner up = £10, loser of heats 1 to 4 = £10 each - 48 different swimmers will have the chance of prize money!
- Other awards as deemed appropriate

Fees: Individual Events = £4.50

Coaches Pass = £15 - programme, results and lunch on both days

Gala Rules

1. The gala is held under ASA Laws and Technical Rules.
2. The pool length is 25 metres.
3. The competition is open to swimmers in the age groups 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15+ years as at 17th June 2012
4. It is the swimmers responsibility to ensure eligibility to enter only events in their own age group.
5. All events, except the Skins competition, will be Heat Declared Winner. Awards will be presented to the three fastest in each age group in both the A and B category, except for the 200m and the 400m Freestyle, where it will be to the three fastest in each age group. Additional awards may be made, depending on the number in each age group/grade.
6. The top 6 male and female competitors from the I.M. races across the qualifying age groups and grades will qualify to take part in the skins competition provided they have not swum faster than the grade improvement time for 15+ or 12. Senior Skins (13+yrs) qualify from the 200m IM; Junior Skins (9 to 12yrs) qualify from the 100m IM. Swimmers will be seeded on qualifying time.
7. Coaches must inform the Entry Official of any swimmers not taking part at least **45 minutes** before the start of each session. Heats will be swum as published in the programme, unless the number of withdrawals, make re-seeding appropriate. **No pool side entries or time only swims are allowed.**
8. Only accredited officials and bona-fide coaches [max 2 per club, unless otherwise agreed] will be allowed on pool side. All persons on poolside must have clearly display their badge at all times.
9. All coaches and team managers will be responsible for their swimmers during the Meet especially during the warm-ups. **No swimmers will be allowed on the balcony seating area.** Entry onto poolside for all swimmers is strictly through the changing rooms only. All swimmers leaving the pool/changing areas must wear footwear. No one should attempt to enter or leave the building using the fire exits, except in the event of an emergency.
10. Swimmers must report to the competitor stewards in the changing rooms one event prior to their event beginning. Competitors not reporting may be scratched from the event. **Swimmers must stay in their marshalled heats until their race.**
11. You are advised not to leave clothing or any other articles lying around, as neither the Gala Promoters nor the Pool Management can accept any responsibility for loss or damage. **NO swimmers bags will be allowed poolside:** please use the lockers in the changing rooms (20p refundable) or the free bag room provided.
12. Space has been allocated to all participating clubs on the window side of the pool. Swimmers should not congregate on the balcony side of the pool as this is required for officials and marshalled swimmers.
13. Any other rules or regulations will be decided by the organisers, and the Referee's decision will be final at all times.
